

ENTERGY'S ROLE



1 REAL BILL SAVINGS

- Residential customers are saving today; saving grows to \$30/month by 2030
- 16% lower than projected rates without data center growth
- Savings come from data centers paying both incremental AND embedded infrastructure costs

2 SMART CONTRACT DESIGN

- Data centers cover their own costs upfront, protecting existing customers
- Long-term contracts with minimum bills and early termination penalties prevent companies from leaving ratepayers holding the bag
- Strong collateral requirements ensure enforcement

3 ROBUST OVERSIGHT (NOT A BLANK CHECK)

- Public Service Commission retains full rate authority
- Independent auditors review all projects
- Public Utilities Staff conduct separate independent review
- All costs scrutinized twice before reaching the Commission
- S.B. 2001 did not remove the Commission's oversight power

4 CONSERVATIVE PROJECTIONS

- 16% figure doesn't include recent AWS expansion in Clinton or other major manufacturers (Modine, ABB, Siemens Energy)
- Actual savings likely to exceed projections as growth continues

5 MISSISSIPPI'S COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE

- While the nation debates data center benefits, Mississippi already answered the question: they benefit existing customers
